Remember, group work is a professional collaboration.

Take turns to speak

Take turns for listening to each group member without interruptions, so everyone is given the chance to explain what they feel is not working and what could be improved. If you are unable to solve the group's problems internally, consider bringing in external help. This could be in the form of a lecturer, student counsellor or the student advice service. Re- member that lecturers and instructors are re- sponsible for and benefit from their students being in successful study groups.
